### Location

### Race starting order

The starting list for the 1<sup>st</sup> heat will be from top to bottom. The first 3 of the European Championship 2019 will start first in the 1<sup>st</sup> heat. The other participants will follow in ranked order. For the unranked participants, the starting positions will be decided by the organizers (after the 20th position).

The 2<sup>nd</sup> heat will be from bottom to top

The final heat will be from slowest to fastest speed. The defending European Champion of each class will however start at last.

All cars will be checked by the FEMA Technical Rules before Training Heat. All safety rules from Track will be based on the FEMA Sporting Code.

## Practice
